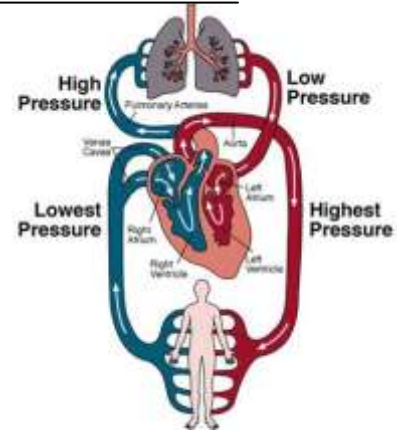


Science with Mrs. McLain

Our scientific studies for

December and January...

Third grade students will learn about the Human Body and how it is composed of several Systems that work together... the Respiratory System, Circulatory System, Nervous System, Digestive System, Excretory System, Integumentary System, Endocrine System, and Immune System.



Fourth grade students will continue their study of Weather and Atmosphere: layers of the atmosphere, the water cycle, the difference between climate and weather, clouds, weather instruments, and how to read weather maps. Can we predict the weather? We will give it a try...



Fifth grade students are finishing the unit of Light, Mirrors, and Lenses. Our next unit will be about Earth's crust, earthquakes, plate tectonics, and weathering. We will conduct hands-on experiments to study the effects of erosion.
